The Alec Dickson Trust awards funding to people aged under 30 who are able to demonstrate that through volunteering or community action, they can enhance the lives of others, particularly those most marginalised by society, (for example, the homeless, those with drug dependency problems and people with disabilities).

### Purpose:

The Alec Dickson Trust will: Fund volunteering projects based in the UK. The Trust particularly welcomes applications from innovative projects in the spirit of Alec Dickson - projects which young people themselves have devised and which are unlikely to be funded by other charitable trusts. As a result, it is unlikely that applications from young people embarking on organised 'gap year' projects overseas (with organisations like Project Trust, Raleigh International, or Health Projects Abroad) or requesting funding for college/university course fees will match with the Trust's funding criteria.

Grant Range: Normally award grants up to £250
